

Chairman's Report for the WGVRFA

The fund stands healthily at £41,414 all frontagers having contributed in the year to January 2020. The committee has not met physically since the last AGM all business being carried-out on line.

Snow clearing and salting was only required once this winter but as reported last year the farmer was forced to use a smaller less effective plough due to overgrown hedges. TDC performed an inspection and the offending hedge has been removed. If you are arranging deliveries, please inform your supplier that the Garden Village has restricted access.

We continue to liaise with The Camp Road/Long Hill Repair Association regarding commuter parking and signage. They have a minimalist approach to street furniture and as a result we have delayed the provision of the speed restriction signs until completion of the development at Graylings.

The committee would like to take the opportunity to welcome new members to the association and I should like to thank Ian Bentley for his efforts over the previous years. Ian has, as you probably know, moved and his place has been taken on the committee by Danny Ord. A thank you also to Yves Allier and Rob Sturgeon for their support and Marie Buckley for auditing our books.
